

Instructions for making

PAVERPOL 3D EFFECT PASTE BLACK/COARSE





You need:

Paverpol black, Art Stone, Paversand black/coarse, sealable jar or bucket, spoon or wooden whisk

Mix:

Mix 100 gram Art Stone little by little with 500 gram Paverpol. Stir until you have a thick, smooth paste. Then add the Paversand, also little by little. This allows you to decide how thick you want the paste to be. The more Paversand you add, the coarser the structure. Apply the paste with your hands or plastic spatula on the workpiece. During drying, nice cracks appear.

Making clay:

Mix 150 gram of Art Stone little by little with 500 gram Paverpol. First mix well, then, if you want, use plastic gloves to knead the clay well. Then, little by little, add Paversand and knead. The more sand, the coarser the structure of the clay. Now you can sculpt with the clay. Also with this method, nice cracks appear during drying.

Possibilities with Paverpol 3D effect paste black/coarse:

The paste can be applied to Paverpol statues that are made with aluminum foil covered with masking tape. The paste also attaches to a variety of other materials such as wood, glass, pottery and sturdy cardboard.

Paint:

After thoroughly drying you can paint it with every paint you like. If you wish, the workpiece, painted with acrylic paint, can be patinated with a mix of Josefine varnish and Pavercolor brown.
